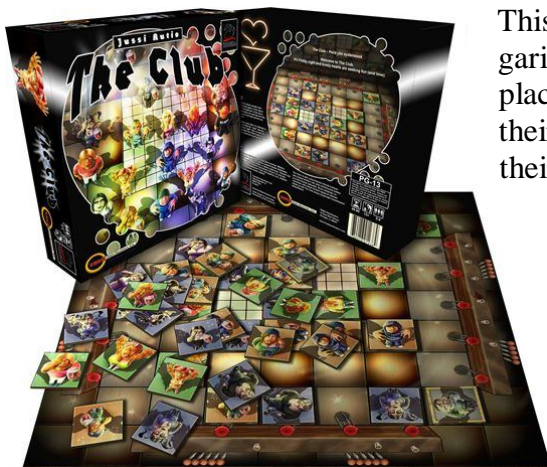
### Brass–2nd edition

This is the Eagle Games edition of Martin Wallace's terrific business game. **Brass** is set in 18th century Lancashire at the beginning of the Industrial Revolution. It starts at the beginning of the Canal Age and ends after the development of railways. Players take the roles of entrepreneurs attempting to make the most money from the various industries of the time. Cotton dominates the game but players ignore the other industries such as coal mining and engineering at their peril.

This is the Eagle Games edition of an intriguing (and rather garish!) board game from Finland. The whole game takes place in a nightclub and the game board is the dance floor. On their turn players push new dancers onto the dance floor from their edge of the board, pushing others towards the centre.

Once two dancers meet, they can become a couple—the better the match, the more points players score.

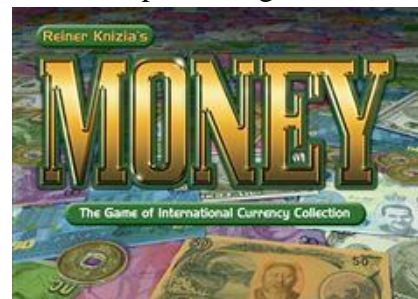

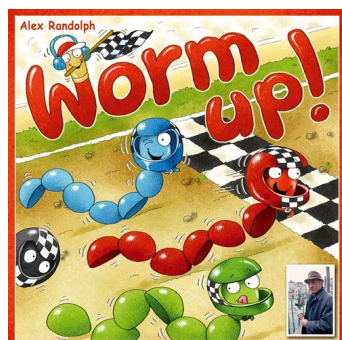
## Money
