

The World Cup Card Game 2010

The greatest single sports show on earth takes place in South Africa this year. **The World Cup Card Game** allows players to play the whole tournament for themselves.

The game consists of 65 cards: 32 represent all the teams taking part. Another 32 are Action cards which are used to create the scorelines for each match. The final card is a summary list of what the Action cards can be used for.

Players start with a random selection of team cards. Depending on the team, they get a number of Action cards, which they use to decide the results in each Group. These produce the score in each match, along with Fouls, Offsides and Penalties.

The best teams from each Group then progress to the knock-out stage. And the last two fight it out in the Final.

Easy to play and a great sequel to the Board game.
